Circle of Seasons Charter School is committed to providing school stability and supports for students who may be experiencing barriers to school enrollment, attendance and participation due to the lack of a permanent residence. Temporary living situations may include:

- Sharing housing with friends or relatives due to the loss of housing
- Public or private shelters
- Public or private spaces such as motels, campgrounds, vehicle, parks, etc.
- Transitional housing programs
- Migrant children
- Runaway youth or abandonment
